## A N O T E F R O M T A M R Y N

---

WOWZA—an acronym for Wave On Wave South Africa—is a God-given initiative with the mandate to release successive waves of salvation, healing, deliverance, and revival across the nation. In 2025, we refined the strategy by tailoring each outreach to the specific needs of the community. Instead of focusing solely on crusades, as we had in 2024, the launch year of WOWZA, we implemented a variety of evangelistic approaches. These ranged from larger, mass crusades and aggressive street preaching to school ministry and pop-up crusades on busy street corners.

Some outreaches spanned only a few days, while others required many months of sustained, on-the-ground engagement. Over 100,000 salvations were recorded in twenty different communities, each location in desperate need of the Gospel, whether due to rampant crime, ancestral worship, substance abuse, witchcraft or gang violence. The new converts were all followed up by local pastors, each initiative—whether large or small—being conducted together with them.



# **DIEPSLOOT & THEMIBISA**


*SUB-PROJECTS OF WOWZA*

The Johannesburg township of Diepsloot is ranked as the second most dangerous informal settlement in South Africa. For the first four months of 2025, a team of zealous soul-winners—headed up by Ev. Rochelle Hicks—moved from church to church, training their members for soul-winning and taking them out onto the streets to preach the Gospel and pray for the sick. They boldly entered taverns, drug dens and witchdoctor initiation homes. They ministered to sinners trapped in the darkest depths of brokenness—and witnessed a floodtide of genuine conversions. Thousands came to Christ and were followed up by the involved pastors. In addition and very importantly, local believers were turned from closet Christians to red-hot witnesses. A local team was established to continue the onslaught of evangelism across their community.





Following their work in Diepsloot, Ev. Rochelle and her team then turned their attention to Thembisa, another Johannesburg township. Once again, they spent some months equipping local believers for evangelism and taking them onto the streets to win the lost. Thousands were again saved and a local team of committed soul-winners was established.





**WOWZA CONT.**



In addition to their work in Diepsloot and Thembisa, our WOWZA evangelists conducted various other outreaches across South Africa. Ev. Lenn Ressou and his team had terrific events and street preaching campaigns in Blikkiesdorp, Wesbank, Delft, Delft South, Happy Valley, Ravensmead, Elsies Rivier, Kraaifontein and Scottsdene, all gang-ravaged communities in the Western Cape. Ev. Elias Mphasha held a powerful, four-day crusade in Mageva, a rural village in the Limpopo, renowned for its witchcraft. Ev. Maans Spamer ministered with his team in Groot Brakrivier—a poor, coastal town infamous for gender-based violence—holding a crusade there.

Ev. Edward Ackerman and his team held crusades in Bredasdorp and Cloetesville, rural communities rife with substance abuse. Ev. Jabu Ndaba held impactful outreaches across Westonaria, a neglected and impoverished Gauteng community. Neo Makhubo and Freddie van Rensburg and their teams travelled between schools and ministered to the youth of Orange Farm, Katlehong, Thokoza and Vosloorus—all townships located in the Gauteng province.






At every outreach, the Lord powerfully touched both young and old. Margaret and Jo-Anne, who had each been confined to wheelchairs after suffering strokes, rose and walked without assistance, weeping under the tangible presence of God. Cate testified that a painful, infected bite on her leg dried up and healed instantly after prayer, enabling her to walk without pain. Mrs Selowa shared how five years of severe pain in her right hand vanished, restoring her ability to cook and wash with ease. Josphina testified that prayer brought freedom from high blood pressure and a profound release from spiritual darkness, allowing her to return to church with a clear mind and renewed hope. In another powerful moment, two witchdoctors sobbed as they confessed the hurts and disappointments that had led them into witchcraft, before surrendering their lives to Jesus as Lord and Saviour.




