


XIKUNDU

Highlights from our crusade in September 24





INTRODUCTION

The community of Xikundu lies in the north of the Limpopo Province of South Africa and is inhabited by the Tsonga people. There is much witchcraft, ancestral worship, broken family units and substance abuse. In the months preceding our crusade there, held from 19-22 September, our team was hard at work preaching the Good News in both Xikundu itself and its surrounding villages. They ministered on the streets and in the schools, evangelising door-to-door, holding marketplace outreaches and executing mini-crusades.

The mass crusade itself was spectacular, although not without its challenges. A cold front swept across the country, bringing with it icy temperatures and excessive snowfall, highly unusual for this time of year—or in South Africa, for any time of year! While no snow fell in Limpopo, the freezing weather and drizzling rain was unyielding. Thankfully, although we were driven indoors to a large, nearby church on the worst of the evenings, giving the people and our sound equipment some respite, the services otherwise continued with zeal. Wonderfully, the people were so hungry for God that they flocked to the crusade field regardless of the unrelenting cold and precipitation!











MIRACLES

Every Gospel message resulted in a floodtide of men and women, young and old, pouring forward to ask Jesus to be their Lord and Saviour. The personal details of the new converts were collected and follow-up material given to them. In total, between our pre-crusade outreaches in Xikundu and the crusade itself, 8,573 people were recorded to say, "Yes!" to Jesus. How glorious! The pastors are thrilled and eagerly involving them in the local congregations.

Prayer for the sick and those in need of deliverance was followed in every service by a steady stream of testimonies. Edward is a 65-year-old widower. Over thirty years ago, he was in an accident and since then, his knees had been terribly painful and his mobility restricted. Every day was a struggle. "I experienced the power of God," he expressed. "I am healed! My life is going to change completely!" Edward kicked his legs on stage, showing off how easily his limbs bent and flexed. Mthavini is a 74-year-old widow and grandmother. Several years ago, her eyesight began deteriorating rapidly and she started having such intense back pains that she could not walk properly. The Lord did a complete work, restoring her sight and invigorating her body. "I am now able to see and walk and will be able to do things for myself," she expressed. "I thank my God for this deliverance!"







HEALING

Susan is 25 years old. She has been terribly ill for several months. "I could not eat," she shared. "Whenever I ate, I would vomit." During prayer, she felt the power of God touching her. "I could feel my whole body shaking. It felt like there was electricity going through me," she voiced. "Now, I am delivered. I thank the Lord Jesus for healing me!" Khensani is a 34-year-old mother of two. One year ago, she started having serious chest problems, her lungs feeling sore and tight. She coughed constantly and had to prop herself up with pillows at night to help her sleep. Her bad health made employment impossible. Tests revealed nothing, no medication helped and she was tired of going from clinic to clinic. During prayer, Khensani felt the pain leaving her chest. She can now breathe easily and all tightness has vanished. "I have such inner peace," she shared. "I feel like a load has been lifted!"




