We have enjoyed a spectacular past few months, both winning the lost and equipping the saints for evangelism. Our Ethiopian team has been on the go in the villages of Gorba and Mula, while our WOWZA evangelists have continued to proclaim Jesus in gang-ravaged communities of Johannesburg. ETHIOPIA





VILLAGE CRUSADES

Our Ethiopian team held two powerful village crusades in the communities of Gorba (1 to 5 April) and Mulo (5 to 10 May). During both outreaches, the team partnered with the local churches to train their members for evangelism, engage in marketplace evangelism, and hold open-air crusades. The Gospel was preached, believers set ablaze for soul-winning, and many encountered the power of Jesus Christ.

Gorba is located in the Western Shoa Region of Ethiopia, and only around 15% of its inhabitants identify as evangelical, while 75% are Orthodox and 10% practise traditional beliefs. During our time there, 550 souls responded to the call of salvation, and many reported being set free from chronic pain, insomnia, and migraines. Mulo is found in the Oromia Region, with 33% of its residents identifying as evangelical, 57% practising Orthodoxy, and 10% practising Islam. As our team ministered there, over 1,600 souls called on the name of the Lord, and testimonies were shared of stomach ulcers, hearing loss, limb impairments, and sinus problems being healed. We thank every partner for standing with us in prayer and giving. Your generosity has enabled us to take the Good News of Christ to these communities!





SOUTH AFRICA





W O W Z A 2 0 2 6

Our WOWZA evangelists have been running with endurance and power across various sectors of Westbury, Johannesburg, over the past few months. They have conducted a total of 28 outreaches thus far, during which over 9,400 people have heard the Gospel, and a glorious 6,256 souls have given their lives to Christ—including many Muslims. They have partnered with nine local churches to train their members for evangelism and equip them to follow up with each new believer. In addition, they ministered in eleven local schools to plant the precious message of Jesus in young hearts and preached the Gospel with boldness at Boksburg Prison on Good Friday. Many testimonies have been recorded of healing from various health issues and freedom from substance abuse. They will continue to hold outreaches in this community throughout June and July. Please keep standing with us in prayer and support as they labour in the harvest field of Westbury.



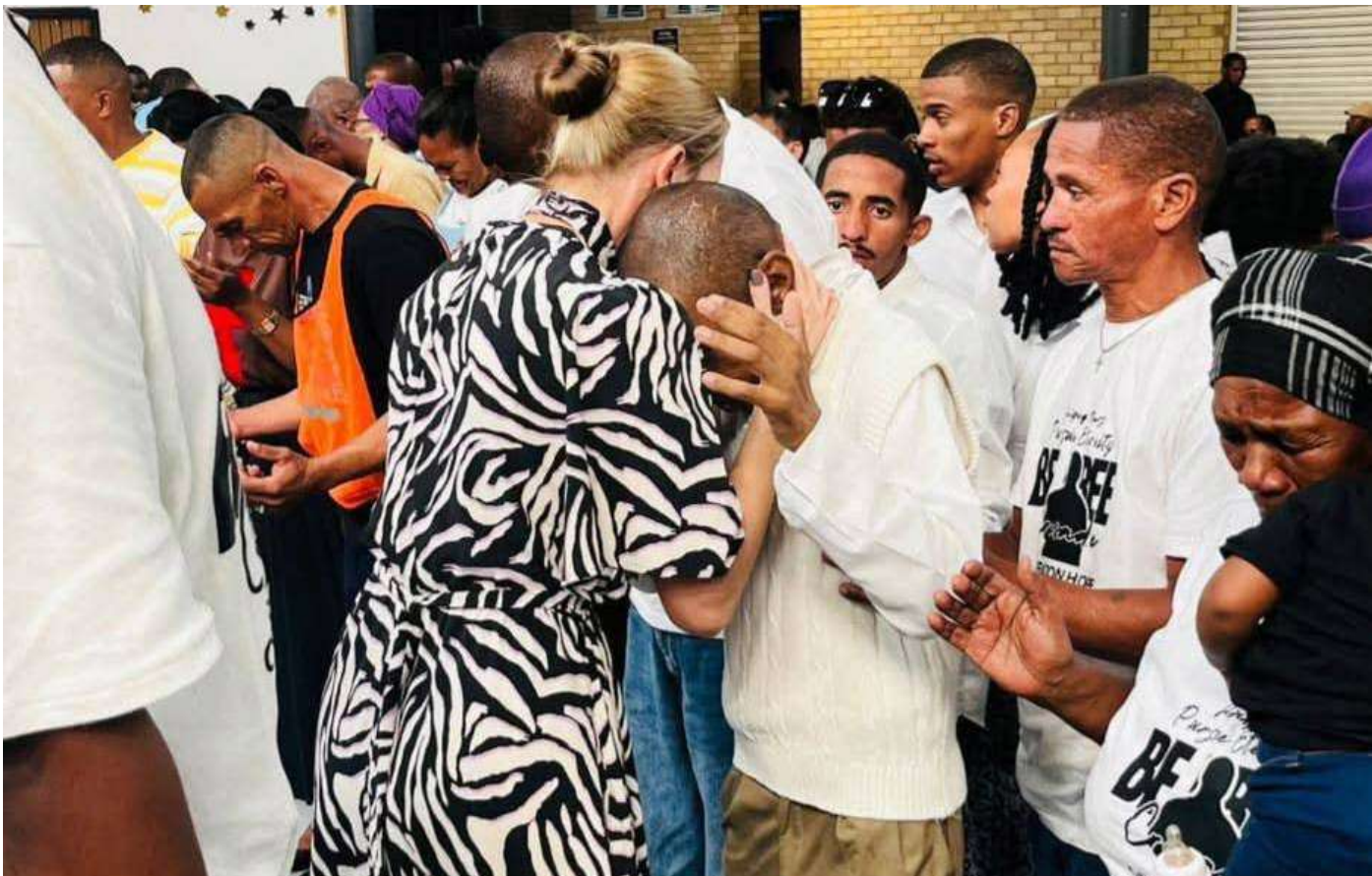


INVITATION EVENTS
